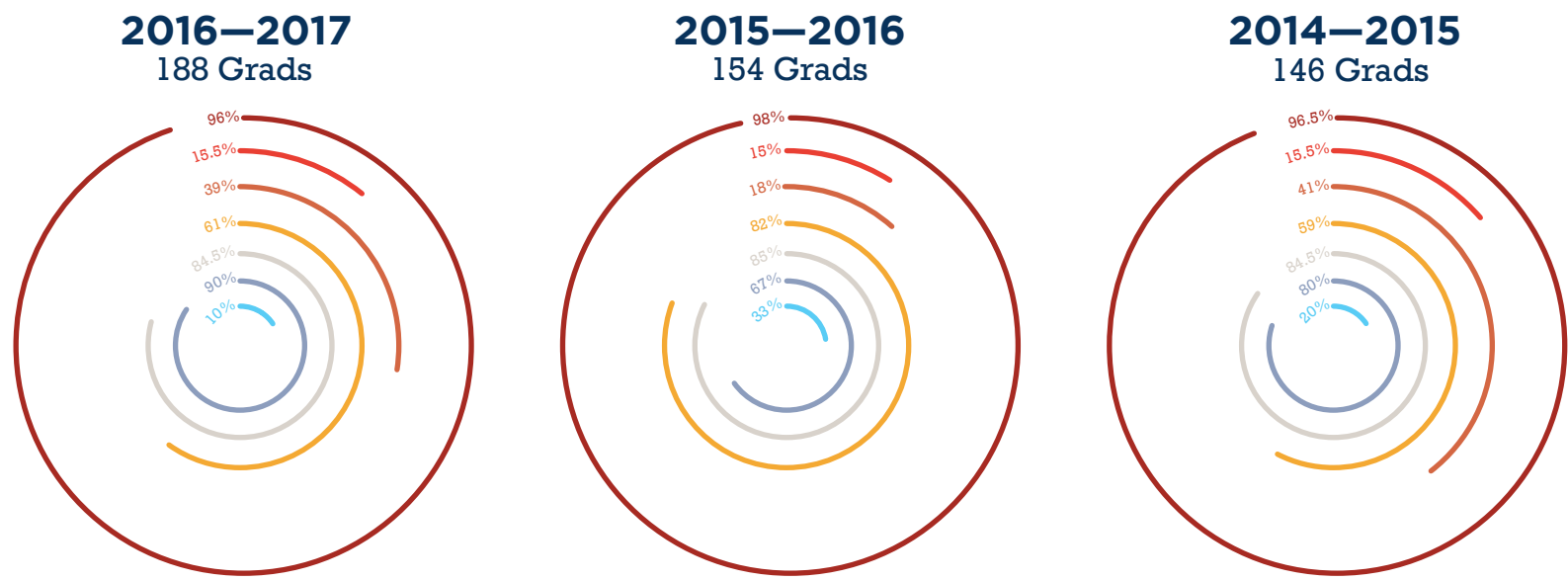

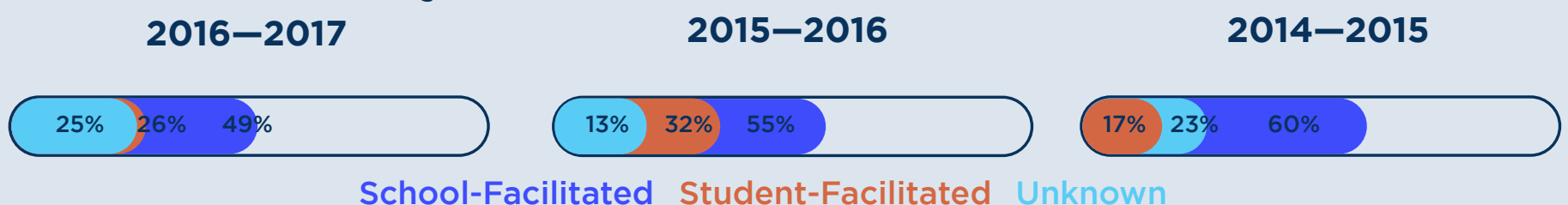


Surveys Completed/Response Rate % Responses Not Seeking Employment Postponing Search/Not Seeking Continuing Education
