The listed graduate business core classes are offered at the KU Edwards Campus in Overland Park, KS in 8-week modules. Six (6) hours of graduate business core classes may be used as electives in the MAcc program. Undergraduate business core classes at the KU Lawrence campus may be substituted with approval, however undergraduate business core classes, while satisfying the prerequisite requirement, will not count in the MAcc program. KU undergraduate business core classes are 3 credit hours and are scheduled in regular 16-week semesters as well as 4-week summer semesters.
